Introduction

TEN ECOPORT (Transnational ENhancement of ECOPORT8 network) is a project co-financed by the South East Europe Transnational Cooperation Programme and implemented since October 2012.

In the framework of the project TEN ECOPORT, the 1st International Conference on "Sustainable development of the sea-corridors and coastal waters" will be organized on **April 3rd, 2014** by the Polytechnic University of Tirana and the Durres Port Authority with the support of the National Institute of Meteorology and Hydrology of the Bulgarian Academy of Sciences and will be held in **Tirana, ALBANIA, at the Polytechnic University of Tirana, Sheshi "Nene Tereza"**.

The Conference will be also supported by all TEN ECOPORT partners and associated organizations.

Basic Objectives of the Conference

The Conference will highlight the advances on Environmental pollution management mainly on ports and coastal zones with special focus on the scientific fields of marine biology and ecology. Marine biology and marine ecology are referred to the study of organisms themselves as well as to how organisms interact with each other in the ocean, open seas, marine environment surrounding ports, or other marine or brackish bodies of water.

Emphasis will be given to water quality, issues that concern the marine environment of sea corridors and coastal waters especially in regions surrounding ports. Also, methodologies, data and instrumentation of monitoring water quality are considered as thematic issues of great importance for the specific Conference.

Contributions and Themes

The Conference invites submissions of research papers and posters on fully-developed results, on-going work or innovative concepts related to marine biology, marine ecology, monitoring methodologies, systems and instrumentation regarding marine environment of sea corridors and coastal waters, especially in regions surrounding ports.

Both **paper and poster presentations** which address recent advances, future tendencies, risks, opportunities and solutions **on one (or more) of the following thematic areas** are welcomed:

- Sustainable coastal management: Systems, policies and strategies at national and international level for achievement of Good Environmental Status

- Biochemical, physiological, and ecological consequences of contaminants to marine organisms and ecosystems
- **Biochemistry**, physiology, behavior, and genetics of marine plants and animals in relation to their ecology
- Biological oceanography and marine geology
- Algorithms and advances in numerical methods for multidisciplinary problems in marine engineering and marine hydrodynamics.

In the framework of the 1st International Conference on "Sustainable development of the sea-corridors and coastal waters", the Local Organizing Committee of the Conference and the Project Partners will invite keynote lectures.

Abstract Submission Information

Abstracts should be **500 -1000 words** and should be received **by the 12th January 2014** the latest via e-mail sent to: **conference@tenecoport.eu**.

Accepted (after double review process) contributions will be presented at the Conference and will be included in *the official conference* **proceedings volume** which will be **published by Springer**.
