

PROVISIONS FOR A PLEASURE BOAT TO BE ENTITLED TO FLY THE ROMANIAN FLAG

The pleasure boat must undergo an initial technical inspection to be entitled to be registered, according to para. (2), Art.71 of OMT 1079/2014, *"is carried out by harbor masters/captain's offices/technical inspectorates for any type of pleasure boat"*.

1. Pleasure boats entered the market/put into service in Romania must satisfy the provisions of Government Decision 464/2017 to regulate the market entry of pleasure boats and personal watercraft, which are transposing the Directive 2013/54/EU. There are no special requirements for manufacturers outside the EU, excepting the situation in which they must be included in the list of third-country boat manufacturers exporting to the EU area and to be available on the European Commission's CIRCABC website.

The pleasure boat shall be supplemented with:

- the Declaration of Conformity of the boat (which also requires the presence of the CE marking on the craft);
- the Declaration of Conformity for the engine;
- the user manual;
- the boat manufacturer's plate;
- the equipment which is related to the assigned navigation area of the craft.

2. Engines installed on pleasure boats shall also comply with the provisions of the Government Decision no. 464/2017, shall be supplemented with the Declaration of Conformity and shall bear the CE marking.

An inspector from the Technical Inspectorate allocated for the proximity of the area where the boat is situated will be nominated to carry out the inspection, the inspection taking place only in the presence and under the coordination of the boat's owner.

A RADIO license (MMSI) is necessary to be achieved. For this you must contact the National Authority for Administration and Regulation in Communications (ANCOM):
